## WORK IN CONFINED SPACE

### Description

Eight (8)-hour course for employees in the industry who may be required to work in confined spaces. Includes four (4) hours of theory and four (4) hours of hands-on practice.

### Course Objectives

Give participants the knowledge required to comply with regulations and safely work in a confined space, by explaining and demonstrating the following :

- Characteristics and hazards of confined spaces ;
- Confined space work legislation ;
- Detection of hazards and use of gas/fume detectors ;
- Site protection measures and Lockout ;
- Stand-by surveillance.

### Through briefings, workshops and drills, participants will learn how to :

- Identify confined spaces ;
- Use gas/fume detectors and identify hazards ;
- Complete entry permits and manage their issue ;
- Identify and eliminate sources of ignition ;
- Select and use protective equipment ;
- Prepare a plan to safely rescue victims ;
- Understand the importance of a safety briefing ;
- Use equipment ;
- Lock out equipment and controls.

### This course is intended for :

- Members of Emergency Response Teams in the industry and public services ;
- Employees who may be required to work in confined spaces.
